Classroom Feature

Words Their Way...what is it?

This program is an approach to spelling that encourages the examination of groups of words for similarities and differences; a way of looking at words and word parts. Spelling lists are differentiated according to students' instructional levels and reflect both a comparison of sound or features and a predictable progression of spelling development as evidenced by research. Students sort words according to these patterns and learn how to spell words using these patterns.

What is expected of my student each week?

Students were given a "Words Their Way Choice Board" at the beginning of the year and we taped a copy of it in the Boomerang Folder. Students need to complete one activity a night for a total of five activities. The activities help the student learn the words patterns and work with the definitions of the words. Students need to study the words on the weekend so they are ready for our test on Monday. *Lately, I can tell that*

students aren't studying as much as they should because our Words Their Way test scores have lowered.
