Math Workshop: What is it and how does it work?

When introducing a new Math topic, I spend one entire class period teaching the concept to the whole class. We work examples and I monitor the students' learning as we work the problems. Once I feel that the class has a strong grasp on the math skill, I assign their assignment to them.

The next day we have Math Workshop! Students love this interactive, hands-on approach to Math. I use the acronym MATH for our activities. Here is how it works:

M=Meet with Teacher (Students who need additional help will meet with me or Mrs. Foster)
A=At Your Seat Work (Students will complete a Quick Quiz of five questions over our topic.)
T=Technology (Students will use our chromebooks to complete an activity or game.)
H=Hands-On (Students will play a game or do an activity using manipulatives.)
